ARHS COVID-19 vaccine supplies are designated for North Carolina residents. While we cannot refuse service, we will only serve residents from other states, including Virginia, after ALL North Carolina residents have been served and only IF we have vaccines available at the time all others have been served. The vaccine system is designed for residents in their home state. Thank you!

The ARHS region has had an influx of out-of-state residents coming to NC to receive the vaccine. While the COVID-19 vaccines are being funded for by Federal monies and anyone can receive it, the vaccine allocation is based on the population for each state and then allotted to each county. ARHS has made a public announcement that they will serve NC residents FIRST, then if they have vaccines leftover they will begin to serve out-of-state residents. Out-of-state residents are being told to turn around and come back at the end of the day.

COVID-19 testing is available for those meeting criteria by appointment only at local health departments.

Testing is available at Pasquotank (252-338-4400) and Camden (252-338-4460) Health Departments on Thursdays. ***Days/Times may shift depending on vaccine clinics.***

Residents are encouraged to call their primary care provider for an assessment or information on testing availability before calling the local health department. If someone does not have a primary care provider, ARHS does offer primary care services.
