Camden and Pasquotank County Sheriff's Office handles the "Project Lifesaver" program. This is a premier search and rescue program that is strategically designed for "at risk" individuals who are prone to the life threatening behavior of wandering. The primary mission of Project Lifesaver is to provide timely response to save lives and reduce potential injury for adults and children with propensity to wander due to a cognitive condition (Autism, Dementia).
