 Chairman Lambertson called for the consideration of the minutes from the June 11, 2007 meeting. A decision was made to postpone approval of the minutes until the next Board of Adjustments meeting, wherein a quorum of persons who were present at the June 11, 2007 meeting would be present. A copy of the June 11, 2007 minutes will be included in the board packet for the next meeting as a matter of reference.

New Business

Item #1, Appeal-Joseph & Judy Coppersmith

In the matter of Joseph and Judith Coppersmith versus the County of Camden County regarding 'Alleged Violation of County Ordinance Chapter 151, Section 334-Table of Permissible Uses, Subsection 6.250-Automobile and Motor Cycle Racing Tracks', the Coppersmiths' entered an appeal on the decision rendered by the Camden County Code Enforcement Officer in an attempt to reverse the decision made by the aforementioned Code Enforcement Officer that the construct located on their property and on the adjacent property, was in violation of said ordinance chapter, section, and subsection.

The Coppersmiths' obtained legal representation in the person of Attorney L. Phillip Hornthall, III. Also present for purposes of witnessing for the Coppersmiths' were Kevin Jones, Mike Underwood, and Tyler Coppersmith. The county was represented in the persons of Attorney John Morrison, and Camden County Code Enforcement Officer Dave Parks.

After all witnesses and counsel were heard from, Francis Eason made a motion to deny the appeal. The motion was 2nd by John Sawyer. A roll call vote was taken: John Sawyer: Deny; William McPherson: Deny; Chairman Roger Lambertson: Deny; Francis Eason: Deny; Janice Hassell: Deny. By a vote of 5-0 (five to zero), the appeal was denied.

After the conclusion of the September 10, 2007 Board of Adjustments Meeting, a transcript of the judicial portion of the proceedings was prepared and provided to both sides in the matter of Coppersmith Vs. the County of Camden County. The aforementioned transcript is filed in the office of the Clerk to the Board of Adjustments.

Item #2, Election of Vice Chairman

Chairman Lambertson opened the floor for nominations for the office of Vice Chairman of the Board of Adjustments. John Sawyer nominated William McPherson, who declined. William McPherson nominated Francis Eason, who is not a voting member and therefore not eligible to hold office. Chairman Lambertson nominated John Sawyer who accepted the nomination. No other nominations were made. A vote was taken. The election of John Sawyer to the office of Vice Chairman was approved with Chairman Roger Lambertson, John L. Sawyer, William McPherson, Janice Hassell, and Francis M. Eason, II voting aye; none voting no; 1 absent; none not voting.

Information from Board and Staff

Item #1 Revocation of Variance (UDO 2006-12-26) - April White

Ms. April White applied for a variance to the minimum roof pitch on a house she brought into the county. The Board of Adjustments granted the variance on certain conditions. One of the conditions was that she obtain a building permit within 15 working days of the approval of the variance. Dave Parks has been working with her on trying to get her to obtain the permit, part of the problem has been obtaining a contractor who will work with her on this house. Since she lives in Florida she can not act as her own contractor on a house built on her property, because under code, if you act as your own contractor you have to live in it for a year. She lives in Florida. Mr. Parks has given her as much time as possible to obtain a contractor. At this time, Mr. Parks feels she has violated the terms of her variance, in failure to obtain the building permit. Mr. Parks has sent her email letting her know that her variance will be revoked and that the construction on the house will have to meet the minimum 6x12 roof pitch. Mr. Parks sought the advice of the Board in handling this item, whether or not he should grant a 30 day extension to Ms. White before revoking her variance.

 Mr. Lambertson asked if Mr. Parks had the authority to grant such an extension. His response was that any extension would have to be preceded by a written request from Ms. White for an extension, after which he did have the authority to grant the extension. Otherwise she would have to apply for another variance.

Mr. Parks informed the board that Ms. White has been in contact with a contractor, a Mr. Brickhouse, and that he will be in to the Planning Department office by the end of the week to obtain the building permit. Mr. Parks would like to give her until the end of the week to comply with the 15 day condition or revoke the variance.

Mr. Eason made comments: Ms. White has 6 months to comply with a 15 day regulation that the board stipulated. Also, she waited until the last minute to reply to Mr. Parks' letter. Mr. Eason said that he has a problem with any extension on this.

Mr. Lambertson reminded the Board that this is an information item, and that the Board only needs to give advice as to what to do. Advice was to not extend the variance and to void and revoke said variance.
