

2020 Filing Notice for Camden County Offices

The Camden County Board of Elections will conduct a Primary Election on Tuesday – March 3, 2020. Candidates seeking election to county offices shall file a Notice of Candidacy at the office of the Camden County Board of Elections.

Filing dates – Candidate filing shall begin at 12:00 noon on Monday – December 2, 2019. Candidate filing shall end at 12:00 noon on Friday – December 20, 2019. All Notices of Candidacy, together with the proper filing fee, must be in the possession of the Camden County Board of Elections by the deadline to be accepted.

County offices on the 2020 Primary ballot include:

- County Commissioners – 3 seats – Courthouse, South Mills, At-Large (4 year terms)
- Register of Deeds – 1 seat (4 year term)

The regular voter registration deadline for the 2020 statewide primary election will be February 7, 2020 (at 5:00 PM). Eligible individuals who miss the regular voter registration deadline may register and voter during the one-stop early voting period.
